A. 応募資格 (Eligibility)

- 奈良女子大学のパートナー大学の女子学生
- 日本語能力試験N3以上
- このプログラムは日本語で行います。

FEMALE students from NWU's overseas partner universities, who have the equivalent level of JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test) N3. This program is conducted in Japanese.

B. 募集人数 (Number of Places Available)

- 12人
- 応募者が多いときは、選考します。

12 students in total will be admitted. If we receive more applicants, they will be subjected to a selection process.

C. 費用 (Costs)

- 授業料・宿泊費：無料

We charge no tuition fees and accommodation costs. Students have to arrange their own visa, international travel insurance, travel to Nara as well as their personal expense.

D. 単位 (Credits)

- 3単位

NWU will issue 3 credits upon students' successful completion of the program.

E. 宿泊 (Accommodation)

- 大学の宿泊施設に宿泊します。
- キッチン、トイレ、バスルーム、洗濯機があります。無料でWi-Fiも使えます。

Students are provided with free university accommodation with shared kitchen, toilet and bathroom, washing machine. Also they can use free Wi-Fi in their accommodation.

F. 応募方法 (How to apply)

- 自分の大学を通じて応募します。

All applications must be made through universities, NOT by individual students. A person in charge at each partner university is required to fill out a collective application form and send it to: iec@cc.nara-wu.ac.jp
