- (2) List of publications and presentations (monographs, published papers, conference presentations, list of acquired external fundings, other works, should be itemized and listed. Published papers should be marked "peer-reviewed" or "not peer-reviewed." Use the specified form.)
- (3) Statement of intent or short essay, describing how you would like to teach and instruct students at Nara Women's University, while touching on your past experiences in education—especially teaching in English at Japanese universities, research, social contributions—academic societies and public committees (approximately 1000 words in English or 2000 letters in Japanese).
- (4) Reprints or photocopies of up to 3 major publications and their summaries (approximately 400 letters in Japanese or 300 words in English).
 - *Use the specified forms for (1) and (2). There is no form for (3) and (4).
 - *Application materials must be sent by registered mail (書留).
