

# PRE-APPLICATION PROCEDURE INTERNATIONAL GRADUATE PROGRAM IN BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES (MASTER'S PROGRAM)

## STEP 1 | REVIEW THE PROGRAM AND RESEARCH FIELDS

Review the program details, research fields, and prospective academic supervisors of the International Graduate Program in Biological Sciences, a program conducted entirely in English, on the following website:

## STEP 2 | SUBMIT A PRE-ADMISSION APPLICATION

April 20 (Mon) – May 8 (Fri), 2026

Complete the online application form and upload the required documents to the designated online storage within the specified period.

## STEP 3 | NOTIFICATION FROM THE ADMISSIONS SUPPORT DESK

The Admissions Support Desk will inform you whether you are permitted to contact a prospective academic supervisor.

## STEP 4 | CONTACT A PROSPECTIVE ACADEMIC SUPERVISOR

If approval is granted, you may contact a prospective academic supervisor directly to discuss whether your proposed research project can be conducted in the supervisor's laboratory.

## STEP 5 | PRE-ADMISSION RESULT

By May 22 (Fri), 2026

You will receive notification of your pre-admission result by email by May 22 (Fri), 2026. The result will be classified as one of the following:

Eligible / Conditionally Eligible / Not Eligible

## STEP 6 | FORMAL APPLICATION

June 15 (Mon) – June 18 (Thu), 2026

Applicants who are deemed Eligible, or Conditionally Eligible and have satisfied the required conditions, may proceed with the formal application. Please submit your application during the application period above. For further details, refer to the [Application Guidelines](#).
